OBITUARIES

Long time FSAACA member, Bill Kilborn passed away on October 16, 2015. He was a member of FSAACA for nearly 4 decades and served as our newsletter editor for many years. He also served as our webmaster since our web sight went live in 2005. The following is his obituary as published by the Watson Funeral Home in Trenton, Florida.

Bill Kilborn was born in Rockford, Illinois in 1937 and died peacefully at home in Trenton on October 16, 2015.

In Bill's early 20's he arrived in Florida and began a career in aviation. His love for photography led him to combine that with his love of flying and he ventured into aviation photography. In 1971 he relocated to Melbourne FL to establish Kilborn Photography which specialized in commercial and aviation photography. No part of Florida escaped Bill's Hasselblad camera and classic 1951 Cessna 170A.



In 2005 Bill moved to Trenton FL, which he bragged about being "The Real Florida." He explored the rivers and wilds of the area and contributed to promoting clean tourism; EcoTourism. His contributions of photos and web sites are still helping to promote this beautiful area while boosting clean tourism and the local economy.

Bill is survived by his companion and best friend, Barbara Hotton, and his friends, Carol and Behdad Forghani.

OLLIE WASHBURN

Ollie was also a long time member of FSAACA and was a fixture at nearly all of the FSAACA events. He and his wife Lorene volunteered for decades at Oshkosh and Sun N Fun. Ollie never missed a chance to jump into one of his homebuilts and fly out for breakfast or lunch, or sometimes both in the same day.

Ollie Washburn, age 83, passed away, Tuesday, December 29, 2015. Ollie and Lorene, his loving wife of 56 years had lived in Florida for 21 years most recently in Wiersdale, moving there from Pittsburgh, PA. He served his country in the US Air Force during the [Korean Conflict](#). Ollie was a corporate pilot for US Steel; retiring after 37 years as Chief Pilot. He was a quiet man and was very deliberate and sincere when he spoke. He had many friends that he made while flying. Ollie loved to fly, built his own plane and last flew just three weeks before he passed away.
